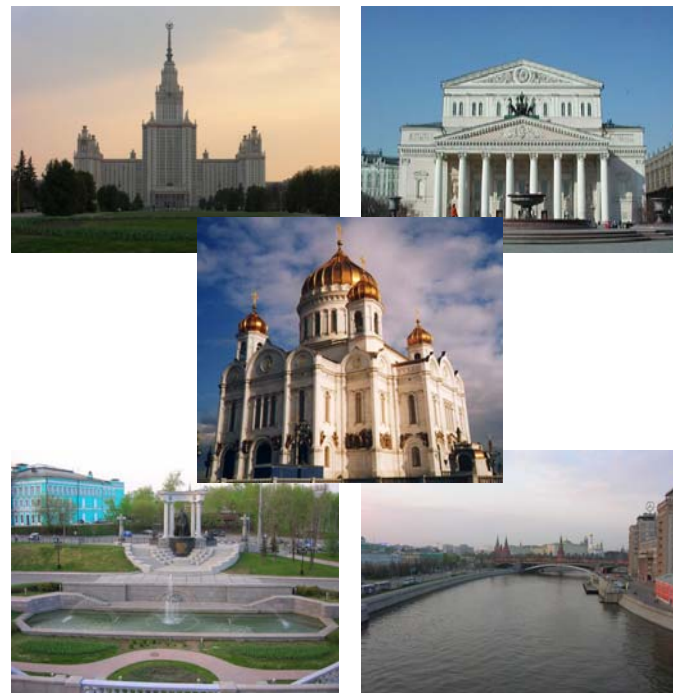

Preliminary Program

The scientific program of the Fourth International Symposium on Computational Methods in Toxicology and Pharmacology Integrating Internet Resources (CMTPI-2007) will encompass:

- 10 plenary lectures, presented by leading scientists from Europe, USA, Japan, Korea, China, India and Russia
- 16 major talks, presented primarily by highly recognized scientists from industry and academia
- 26 oral communications which will be selected from submitted abstracts
- a poster session

Instruction for Abstracts Submission

Typing should be word-processed/typed in English using one and a half line spacing and Times New Roman 12-point font on a single sheet of A4 white paper.

1. Paper - A4, margins: left - 3 cm, up and down - 2.5 cm, right - 2 cm.
2. Title (clear and concise) - should be typed in capital letters (ALL CAPS).
3. Author's names - full first name, middle initial, last name (in that order).

Indicate author affiliations by superscripts (if authors are from more than a single affiliation) and underline the name of the presenting author.

4. Authors' affiliations and addresses. Please provide also e-mail address of the presenting author.
5. Leave blank lines between the title and Author's names and affiliations and the abstract text.
6. The Abstract text should describe the work to be presented with minimum introduction. A promise of results and/or discussion is not appropriate. Acknowledgements and references should be kept to a minimum. It should be within 2000 letters in length without blanks, no indentations.
7. Save the file - as "first name_last name.rtf" for submission in Rich Text Format (for example: john_smith.rtf).

Faxed abstracts will not be accepted under any circumstances.

Proceedings

The proceedings of the CMTPI-2007 meeting will be published in *SAR and QSAR in Environmental Research* (Taylor & Francis).

All the poster and oral presenters are invited to submit a manuscript to the proceedings. The length of the papers is limited to twelve SQER pages including tables and figures (onfiltered= 440 words \pm 10%).

To expedite publication ALL MANUSCRIPTS MUST BE SUBMITTED BEFORE SEPTEMBER 2, 2007. No exception to this rule will be accepted. Early submissions via the Internet before the meeting are particularly welcome but imperatively before August 20.

All submissions must be correctly formatted. One original and two copies of the manuscript, in addition to an electronic copy (CD), should be submitted to Prof. Vladimir Poroikov or Dr. James Devillers. Each paper will be reviewed by at least two referees.

Period of visa's legalization may take about 1,5-2 months, so participants should data necessary to obtain a visa in advance. Organizers will prepare the request to Russian Ministry of Foreign Affairs, and after the confirmation by the Ministry will send to the participant his/her personal number. With this number the participant will get a visa in the local Russian Consulate.
