This issue contains a selection of scientific contributions presented at the Eighth Brazilian Symposium of Theoretical Chemistry, held in Caxambú, M.G., Brazil, 19–22 November 1995.

The need for a Brazilian meeting on theoretical chemistry became apparent on occasion of the First Symposium of Theoretical Chemistry in Rio de Janeiro in 1980. Since then the Symposium has been organized every two years.
