INTRODUCTION

The 8th Scandinavian Symposium on Chemometrics (SSC8) will be held in the Assembly Hall in the Self-Government Building, Mariehamn, Åland, June 14-18, 2003. The Symposium will cover different branches of chemistry where chemometrics is applied and contributing significantly to scientific or technical progress.

The meeting brings together researchers in the field of chemometrics. It will provide excellent opportunities for extended discussions and exchange of views regarding the application of chemometrics.

SSC8 will include all aspects of chemometrics, but will emphasize on applications in the following topics:

STUDENT GRANTS

Letters of application are due March 14, 2003. A letter of support from the faculty research advisor must accompany each letter as well as a copy of the submitted abstract.

Recipients will be selected from young Chemometricians giving the best presentations at SSC8 (oral or poster). The recipients will receive their prizes in connection with the fifth Herman Wold medal ceremony.
